Willamette Realocation Lawsuit: Gail Greenway updated us on the lawsuit. On the legislative side, OFB is working with congressional offices. US Representative Peter DeFazio is chairman of the committee that oversees the land use and will be turning his attention to the Water Resources Development Act. On the litigation side, Farm Bureau is engaged as an intervener, this is the more expensive route but gives us a "seat at the table." It's hard to give a timeline, but looking at years, not months.
